Records exist of a race meeting in Oodnadatta first being held in 1891, one year after the town was founded. Oodnadatta Racing and Horse Sports Club is run by volunteers from the town and nearby cattle stations. The Club want to provide good social gatherings which bring the community together.

Each year the club plays host to three major events:

- 20/20 cricket match in March: Town vs Stations
- Races in May: the longest running picnic race meeting in Australia
- Campdraft and Bronco Branding in July
